Full refunds are granted in the event a class is full or cancelled by the Recreation Department. ALL refunds will follow the Finance Department's bill paying schedule and will be issued by township check (no cash refunds). Allow 4~6 weeks for refund to be processed.

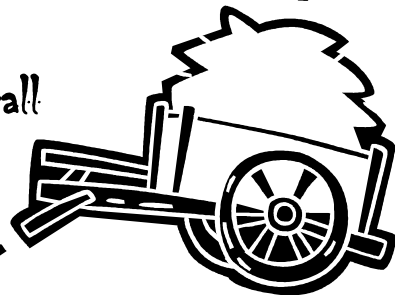

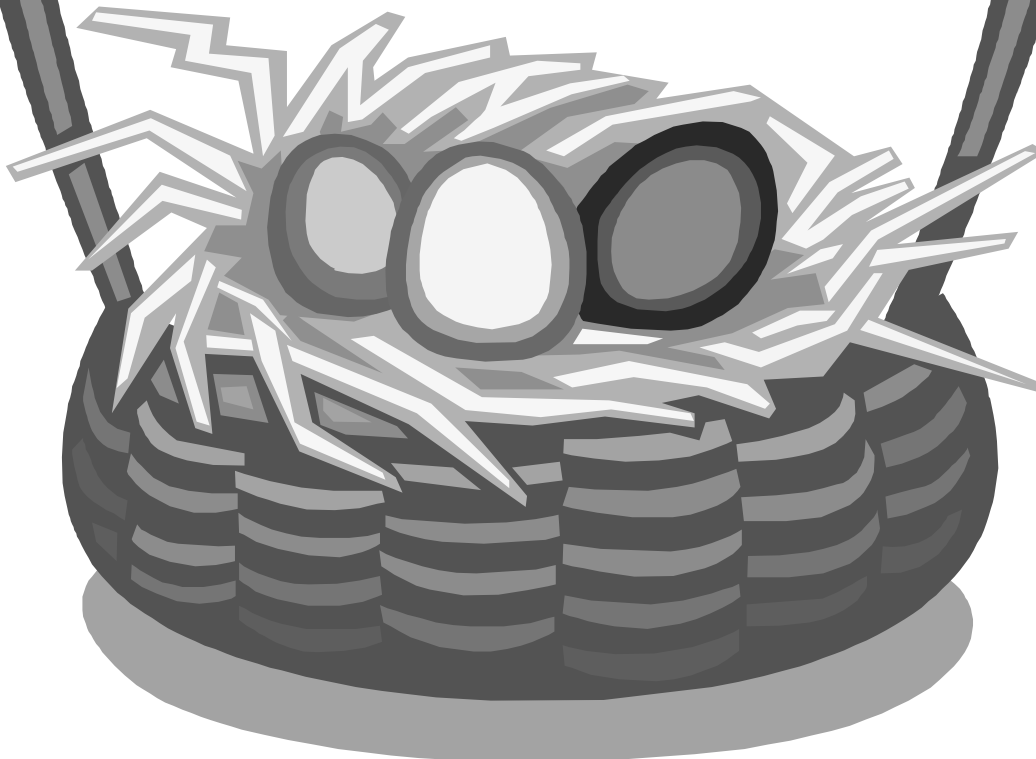
