ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER THE TOWNSHIP CODE. "PROPERTY 313 OF ENTITLED MAINTENANCE" IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR A SECTION 313-25 ENTITLED "REGISTRATION OF VACANT AND ABANDONED PROPERTIES"

WHEREAS, the Township of Manchester Township (hereinafter referred to as the "Township") contains structures which are vacant and/or abandoned in whole or in large part; and

WHEREAS, in many cases, the owners or responsible parties of these structures are neglectful of them, are not maintaining or securing them to an adequate standard or restoring them to productive use; and

WHEREAS, these abandoned and/or vacant properties have a negative effect on the quality of life of the Township, increasing the risk of property damage through arson and vandalism and discouraging neighborhood stability and revitalization; and

WHEREAS, it has been established that vacant and abandoned structures cause severe harm to the health, safety and general welfare of the community, including diminution of neighboring property values, increased risk of fire, potential increases in criminal activity and public health risks; and

WHEREAS, the Township incurs disproportionate costs in order to deal with the problems of vacant and abandoned structures, including but not limited to excessive police calls, fire calls and property inspections; and

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WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Township to establish minimum standards of accountability of the owners or responsible parties of these vacant and abandoned structures in order to protect the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of Manchester; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the Township to impose a fee in conjunction with registration of vacant and abandoned structures in light of the disproportionate costs imposed on the Township by the presence of these structures.

SECTION 313-25 "REGISTRATION OF VACANT AND ABANDONED PROPERTIES"

SECTION 313-25.1

Maintenance of Vacant/Abandoned Properties.

Definitions.

Owner – Shall mean and include the title holder, any agent of the title holder having authority to act with respect to a vacant property, any foreclosing entity subject to the provisions N.J.S.A. 46:10B-51 (P.L. 2008, c. 127, Sec. 17 as amended by P.L. 2009, c. 296), or any other entity determined by the Township of Manchester to have authority to act with respect to the property.

<u>Vacant/Abandoned Property</u> – Any building used or to be used as a residence, commercial or industrial structure which is not legally occupied or at which substantially all lawful construction operations or residential occupancy has ceased, and which is in such condition that it cannot legally be reoccupied without repair or rehabilitation, including but not limited to any property meeting the definition of abandoned property in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 55:19-80 et seq.; provided, however, that any property where all building systems are in working order, where the building and grounds are maintained in good order, or where the building is in habitable condition, and where the building is being actively marketed by its owner for sale or rental, shall not be deemed a vacant property for purposes of this section.

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SECTION 313-25.2

Registration requirements.

- a. Each property having a separate block and lot number as designated in official records of the municipality shall be registered separately.
- b. The registration statement shall include the name, street address, telephone number and email address (if applicable) of a person 21 years or older, designated by the owner or owners as the authorized agent for receiving notices of code violations and for receiving process in any court proceeding or administrative enforcement proceedings on behalf of such owner or owners in connection with the enforcement of any applicable code; and the name, street address, telephone number and email (if applicable) of the firm and the actual name(s) of the firms individual principal(s) responsible for maintaining the property. The individual or representative of the firm responsible for maintaining the property shall be available by telephone or in person on a 24 hour per day, seven-day per week basis. The two entities may be the same or different persons. Both entities shown on the statement must maintain offices in the State of New Jersey or reside within the State of New Jersey.
- c. The registration shall remain valid until December 31st of the year in which the application is made. The owner shall be required to renew the registration annually in the month of January. Deadline for registration renewal shall be January 31st as long as the building remains a vacant and/or abandoned property and shall pay a registration or renewal fee in the amount prescribed in Section 313-25.5 of this Ordinance, for each vacant property registered.
- d. The owner shall notify the Clerk within 30 calendar days of any change in the registration information by filing an amended registration statement on a form provided by the Clerk for such purpose.
- e. The registration statement shall be deemed *prima facie* proof of the statements therein contained in any administrative enforcement proceeding or court proceeding instituted by the Township against the owner or owners of the building.

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SECTION 313-25.3

Access to vacant properties.

The owner of any vacant property registered under this Ordinance shall provide access to the Township to conduct exterior and interior inspections of the building to determine compliance with municipal codes, upon reasonable notice to the property owner or the designated agent. Such inspections shall be carried out on weekdays during the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., or such other time as may be mutually agreed upon between the owner and the Township.

SECTION 313-25.4 Responsible Owner or Agent.

- a. An owner who meets the requirements of this Ordinance with respect to the location of his or her property or workplace in the State of New Jersey may designate him or herself as agent or as the individual responsible for maintaining the property.
- b. By designating an authorized agent under the provisions of this Section the owner consents to receive any and all notices of code violations concerning the registered vacant property and all process in any court proceeding or administrative enforcement proceeding brought to enforce code provisions concerning the registered building by service of the notice of process on the authorized agent. Any owner who has designated an authorized agent under the provisions of this section shall be deemed to consent to the continuation of the agent's designation for the purposes of this Section until the owner files a new annual registration statement.
- c. Any owner who fails to register vacant/abandoned property under the provisions of this Ordinance shall further be deemed to consent to receive, by posting on the building, in plain view, and by service of notice at the last known address of the owner of the property on record within the Township by regular and certified mail, any and all notices of code violations and all process in an administrative proceeding brought to enforce code provisions concerning the building.

SECTION 313-25.5 Fee Schedule.

The initial registration fee for each property upon the 2016 adoption of these provisions shall be seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00) dollars if registration is applicable and property qualifies before July 1, 2016. If the property meets the required registration criteria after July 1, 2016, then the fee shall be five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. From January 1, 2017 forward, the initial registration fee hereinafter shall be one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars for the first year; which the initial registration shall be prorated to five hundred (\$500.00) if qualified after July 1st of the first year. The fee for the first renewal is two thousand (\$2,000) dollars and the fee for the second renewal is three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars. The fee for any subsequent renewal beyond the second renewal is five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars.

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Vacant property Registration Fee Schedule

Initial Registration \$750.00 (\$1000.00 January 1, 2017 forward)

First Renewal \$2,000.00 Second Renewal \$3,000.00 Subsequent Renewal \$5,000.00

SECTION 313-25.6 Requirements of Owners of Vacant Properties.

The owner of any building that has become vacant/abandoned property, and any person maintaining or operating or collecting rent for any such building that has become vacant shall, within thirty (30) days thereof:

- a. Enclose and secure the building against unauthorized entry as provided in the applicable provisions of the Township Code, or as set forth in the rules and regulations supplementing those codes; and
- b. Post a sign affixed to the building indicating the name, address and telephone number of the owner, the owner's authorized agent for the purpose of service of process, and the person responsible for day-to-day supervision and management of the building, if such person is different from the owner holding title or authorized agent. The sign shall be of a size and placed in such a location so as to be legible from the nearest public street or sidewalk whichever is nearer, but shall be no smaller than eight (8) inches by ten (10) inches; and
- c. Secure the building from unauthorized entry and maintain the sign until the building is again legally occupied or demolished or until repair or rehabilitation of the building is complete; and
- d. Ensure that the exterior grounds of the structure, including yards, fences, sidewalks, walkways, right-of-ways, alleys, retaining walls, attached or unattached accessory structures and driveways, are well-maintained and free from trash, debris, loose litter, and grass and weed growth; and
- e. Continue to maintain the structure in a secure and closed condition, keep the grounds in a clean and well-maintained condition, and ensure that the sign is visible and intact until the building is again occupied, demolished, or until repair and/or rehabilitation of the building is complete.

SECTION 313-25.7 Violations.

a. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance or the rules and regulations issued hereunder shall be fined no less than \$100.00 and not more than

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\$2,500.00 for each offense. Every day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. Fines assessed under this Chapter shall be recoverable from the owner and shall be a lien on the property.

- b. For purposes of this section, failure to file a registration statement within 30 calendar days after a building becomes vacant property or within 30 calendar days after assuming ownership of a vacant property, whichever is later, or within 10 calendar days of receipt of notice by the municipality and failure to provide correct information on the registration statement, or failure to comply with the provision of such provisions contained herein shall be deemed to be violations of this Ordinance.
- c. The provisions of this section shall be enforced by Township enforcing officials, including but not limited to the Code Enforcement Office.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Manchester as follows:

SECTION 8. Severability. The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 9. Repealer. Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 10. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official newspaper of the Township, as required by and in conformance with law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER ENTITLED TRAFFIC

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter VII of the Code of the Township of Manchester entitled "Traffic," § 7-26 entitled "Turn prohibitions", shall be amended and supplemented to read as follows:

No person shall make a turn at any location listed, except only in the manner described.

Intersection	Direction of Travel	Regulations
Township Line Road and Pinewald - Keswick Road (Ocean County Route 530)	Township Line Road western lane (right-turn lane)	No left turn (right turn only and only from turn lane)
Township Line Road and Pinewald - Keswick Road (Ocean County Route 530)	Township Line Road eastern lane (left-turn lane)	No right turn (left turn only and only from turn lane)
Wilbur Avenue and New Jersey State Highway Route 70	Wilbur Avenue Southbound	No left turn on to Route 70 Eastbound

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance not directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to the provisions of <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:69A-181(b), this Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage by the Township Council and approval by the Mayor where such approval is required by law.

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 261 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER ENTITLED, "LICENSING AND ADMINISTRATION OF REWARD TYPE PROGRAMS".

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey desires to stimulate local commerce in Manchester Township by encouraging the patronage of Manchester Township—based businesses by Township residents; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that it is appropriate to permit "reward" type programs that act as enhancements to the "Shop Manchester" program which will give Manchester Township taxpayers a financial incentive to patronize participating Manchester Township—based businesses through the payment of residential property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the license shall permit vendors to register interested residents and Manchester Township-based businesses who desire to participate; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Manchester Township believes that the implementation of this system will benefit Manchester Township-based businesses and resident taxpayers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester Township, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that Section 261 of the Code of the Township of Manchester entitled "Licensing and Administration of Reward-Type Programs" be and hereby is established as follows:



SECTION 1. "General Licensing".

§261-1 Licensing and Administration of Reward-Type Programs.

- A. Any vendor who offers reward programs which includes the payment of taxes for Manchester Township taxpayers who shop at participating Manchester Township-based businesses shall before implementing such a program obtain a license as provided for in this Ordinance.
- B. This program shall be administered solely by the vendor who shall undertake to register interested parties in Manchester Township-based businesses.
- C. The vendor shall pay to the Township a License Fee in the amount \$25.00 yearly and shall submit to the Township Administrator all information necessary as may be reasonably required in order to determine the truth or validity of the statements contained in the application.
- D. Conditions. The Township shall establish the necessary reporting requirements for any payment of taxes made to Manchester Township by the vendor. The Township shall not be responsible for any impact of program participation on mortgage escrow calculations. The Township shall not be responsible for any changes in property ownership.

SECTION 2. Severability. The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 3. Repealer. Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication in an official newspaper of the Township, as required by and in conformance with law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER FOR THE TOWNSHIP RELATED EXPENSES \$1,360,000 THEREFOR. **AND** APPROPRIATING PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,292,000 IN NOTES THE **TOWNSHIP OF** BONDS OR **OF** MANCHESTER TO FINANCE THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The several improvements or purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Manchester, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Township") as general improvements. For the several improvements or purposes described in Section 3 hereof, there are hereby appropriated the respective sums of money therein stated as the appropriations made for each improvement or purpose, such sums amounting in the aggregate to \$1,360,000 including the aggregate sum of \$68,000 as the several down payments for the improvements or purposes required by the Local Bond Law. The aggregate down payments have been made available by virtue of provision for down payment for capital improvement purposes in one or more previously adopted budgets..

Section 2. In order to finance the cost of the several improvements or purposes not covered by application of the several down payments, negotiable bonds or notes are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$1,292,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law. In anticipation of the issuance of the bonds or notes, negotiable bond anticipation notes are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

Section 3. (a) The several improvements hereby authorized and the several purposes for which the bonds or notes are to be issued, the estimated cost of each improvement and the appropriation therefor, the maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for each improvement and the period of usefulness of each improvement are as follows:

(1) Purpose:

Acquisition of various technology for the Police Department including, but not limited to, mobile data terminals, automatic vehicle location hardware, system hardware and servers, data conversion, radio and telephone recording system, alcotest machine and police dispatch radio consoles, and including all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

Appropriation and Estimated Cost:	\$577,500
Maximum Amount of Bonds or Notes:	\$548,625
Period or Average Period of Usefulness:	7 years
Amount of Down Payment:	\$ 28,875

(2) <u>Purpose</u>:

Acquisition of miscellaneous equipment for the Police department, including, but not limited to a crash data recorder and auto license plate recognition, and including all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

Appropriation and Estimated Cost:	\$32,500
Maximum Amount of Bonds or Notes:	\$30,875
Period or Average Period of Usefulness:	15 years
Amount of Down Payment:	\$ 1,625

(3) Purpose:

Acquisition of various technology/communication equipment, including, but not limited to, dual band portable radios for the SWAT, Chief, Deputy Chief and crew of the fire department, portable chargers, dual band mobile radios and portable radios for the first aid ambulances, fire pagers and first aid pagers, and including all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

Appropriation and Estimated Cost:\$427,500Maximum Amount of Bonds or Notes:\$406,125Period or Average Period of Usefulness:10 yearsAmount of Down Payment:\$ 21,375

(4) <u>Purpose</u>: Acquisition and installation of generators for

various volunteer Fire Department sites, and including all work and materials necessary therefor

or incidental thereto.

Appropriation and Estimated Cost:\$322,500Amount of Bonds or Notes:\$306,375Period or Average Period of Usefulness:15 yearsAmount of Down Payment:\$ 16,125

- (b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for the several improvements or purposes is as stated in Section 2 hereof.
- (c) The estimated cost of the several improvements or purposes is equal to the amount of the appropriation herein made therefor.

Section 4. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the chief financial officer; provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the chief financial officer. The chief financial officer shall determine all matters in connection with notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the chief financial officer's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-8.1. The chief financial officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time, at not less than par and accrued interest, at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The chief financial officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 5. The capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget, as applicable and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 6. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

- (a) The several improvements or purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are not current expenses. They are improvements or purposes the Township may lawfully undertake as general improvements, and no part of the costs thereof have been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.
- (b) The average period of usefulness of the several improvements or purposes, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, computed on the basis of the respective amounts or obligations authorized for each improvement or purpose and the reasonable life thereof within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, is 10.11 years.
- (c) The Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly prepared and filed in the office of the Clerk, and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Township as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided in this bond ordinance by \$1,292,000 and the obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by that Law.

WHEREAS, the Township of Manchester regulated peddling and soliciting within the Township of Manchester, by and through Chapter 301 of the Code of the Township of Manchester; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to enact a new section to create a "Do No Knock Registry" to permit Township residents to register with the Township Clerk indicating that they do not want hawkers, peddlers, solicitors or canvassers to approach their homes and/or seek contact with the occupants of the registered home; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Manchester finds its in its best interest to amend Chapter 301 in order to provide Township residents with the option of registering for a "Do No Knock Registry;" and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester Township, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that Section 301 of the Code of the Township of Manchester entitled "Peddling and Soliciting" be and hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 301, Section 21, "No Knock List" shall be adopted to provide as follows:

§301-21 Do No Knock Registry



- A. All residents of the Township of Manchester may register their address with the Township Clerk to be placed on the "Do No Knock Registry," indicating that they do not want peddling, itinerant vending and door-to-door sales enterprises to approach their homes on their premises. Registration shall be by completion of a form made available by the Township Clerk's office.
- B. Residents shall remain on the "Do Not Knock Registry" until such time as they advise the Township Clerk in writing that they wish to be removed from the list.
- C. Any resident registered on the Do No Knock Registry, pursuant to Subsection A herein, shall be able to procure from the Clerk's office a sticker for display at the residence indicating enlistment on the Manchester Township Do Not Knock Registry. The first sticker shall be provided free of charge and may be picked up in person during regular business hours. If a replacement sticker is required, the individual may pick up a replacement at the Clerk's office at no charge. A fee of \$1 will be applied for any individual who desires to have the sticker mailed to him or her, which shall be payable to the Township Clerk. The sticker must be displayed in a clearly visible location.
- D. The Township Clerk shall maintain the Do Not Knock Registry and allow inspection of the addresses on the registry to all persons or entities required to obtain a permit under Chapter 301. A copy of the Do Not Knock Registry can be provided for a fee in accordance with N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.
- E. It shall be unlawful for any person or entity required to obtain a permit pursuant to Chapter 301 to enter the approach and/or seek contact from a residence registered on the Do Not Knock Registry.
- F. Any person subject to this chapter who violates any provision of this section shall be subject to a maximum ordinance violation per offense as provided in § 301-22.

§301-21 22 Any person violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, by imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days and/or by a period of community service not to exceed 90 days, in the discretion of the Judge. The continuation of such violation for each successive day shall constitute a separate offense, and the person or persons allowing or permitting the continuation of the violation may be punished as provided above for each separate offense.

SECTION 2. Severability. The various parts, sections and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is

adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the

Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
