### AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 245 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER ENTITLED LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT.

**BE IT ORDERED** by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter 245 of the code of the Township of Manchester entitled "Land Use and Development", more specifically Section 245-13 E "Approving agency submission procedures" be and hereby is amended and supplemented as follows:

E. Appeals to the governing body from the Board of Adjustment. Any interested party may appeal to a court of competent jurisdiction the Township Council any final decision of the Board of Adjustment approving an application pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-70d. Such appeal shall be made within 10 days of the date of the publication of such final decision pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-10i. The appeal to the Township Council shall be made by serving the Township Clerk in person or by certified mail with a notice of appeal, specifying the grounds thereof and the name and address of the appealant and the name and address of his attorney, if represented. Any qualifying vehicle over 8000 pounds Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) so parked or stored on any residential lot as outlined in this chapter may not be so parked or stored unless the vehicle is set back no less than 35 feet from any front, back or side property line.
