# MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP MEETING MINUTES April 27, 2015

The meeting of the Manchester Township Council was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Council President Brendan Weiner. The following statement was read by the Municipal Clerk:

### **PRESENTATION -** Buy-In Property Tax Rewards Program – FinCredit Inc.

Carmine De Falco of FinCredit Inc., gave a presentation on the Buy-In Property Tax Rewards Program. Businesses within the Township would offer residents a discount if they shopped at their establishment. The discount would go towards the resident's property tax. The pros and cons of this program were discussed. Some concerns that Council had were that big box stores do not participate and how much savings would be realized for residents.
