Bruce Stiers 27 Schoolhouse Road Whiting, NJ 08759 Block 90 Lot 19 27 Schoolhouse Road WTRC Zone

Mr. Stiers needs a variance to install a 25' x 25' ground-mounted solar panel array having a 5' side yard setback where 15' is required. Mr. Bruce Stiers was sworn in by Mr. Reid. He would like to install a ground mounted solar array. His property is surrounded with very large trees and this is the only area he can install a solar array and it receive sunlight to make it worthwhile. The solar array will be installed in his back yard, which has a 6' fence surrounding it. No one lives to the south or east of him, which is the area immediately adjacent to the solar array. It will not be able to be seen from the road. He feels it is environmentally friendly. It makes no noise, its green. Mr. Cook made him aware that if he decided to make any changes he would have to come back before the Board. Mr. Stiers stated the panels would be pointing due south with a maximum height of 12 feet. There are very large trees along the front & rear of his property. This is the only area in his yard that they would be able to be installed to be effective. He couldn't put them on the roof because he would have to cut down a lot of very large trees.

Mrs. Fazio opened this portion of the meeting to the public. There being no public participation at this time, this portion of the meeting was closed.
