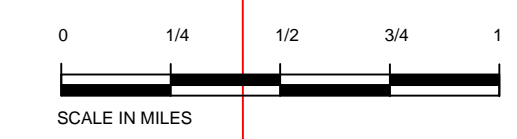

Manchester Township is a rural/suburban community located in north central Ocean County. It is bordered to the south by Berkeley and Lacey Townships, to the west by Woodland and Pemberton Townships (Burlington County) to the east by Dover Township and to the north by Plumstead and Jackson Townships. The Township's relatively large size, 82.50 square miles, makes it second in area only to Jackson Township among the County's 33 municipalities. The estimated population of Manchester is estimated by the U.S. Census (year 2000) to be 38,924. Of this total nearly 55 percent are age 65 or greater. Manchester has several retirement communities which accounts for the relatively large percentage of the population. New Jersey State Highway 70 is the major roadway traversing the Township. Other major roadways include County Routes 530, 539, 547, 571 and New Jersey State Highway 37.
