DIRECTIONS TO PINE RIDGE GOLF COURSE AT JBMDL GOLF COMPLEX

**Address: Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst - Military
and Family Support Center, County Rte 547,
Lakehurst, NJ 08753**

From the West: Drive east on Rt. 70 to the Lakehurst
(Eisenhower) traffic circle. Continue on Rt. 70 East for 3/4
mile. Make left onto Rt. 547 (landmark: Lakehurst Diner at
Rt. 547 traffic light). Entrance is 2/3 mile up on the left
(airplane at entrance). See "**On-Base Directions**" below.

From the East: Drive west on Rt. 37 to the Rt. 70 traffic circle
and merge onto Rt. 70 West. Continue 1/3 mile and turn
right onto Rt. 547 (landmark: Lakehurst Diner at Rt. 547
traffic light). Entrance is 2/3 mile up on the left (airplane at
entrance). See "**On-Base Directions**" below.

On-Base Directions: Proceed past front gate on entrance
road (Landsdowne Rd.) past larger hanger (Hanger One) on
your left. Just past the hanger you will see three jet aircraft on
display (Lakehurst Air Park). Bear right just after the jets
(this will be Landsdowne Rd.) Take fourth right onto
Bushnell Rd. (sign for golf course). Go downhill to stop sign
and make a left. Then make first left into parking lot for
Building 33, which is the golf clubhouse.

**"Honoring All Who Have Served"
Veterans Memorial**



The Manchester Township Veterans' Advisory Committee is planning the "Honoring All Who Have Served" Memorial within World War II Veterans Memorial Park in Whiting to pay tribute to the heroic efforts of our men and women veterans.

The focal point of the monument will be a large gazebo with benches to provide a peaceful place to sit and reflect. In addition, carved granite structures will be erected behind the gazebo with bronze plates honoring veterans of the Korean war, Vietnam war, Persian Gulf war, Operation Iraqi Freedom and all Women Veterans.

The \$100,000 cost of the monument will be funded through donations and fundraising.
