NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:


1. That the Township Council hereby supports the passage of S-2776 "Prohibiting use of plastic carryout bags, expanded polystyrene and single-use plastic straws."
