ENERGY AGGREGATION PRESENTATION

Bob Chilton presented the 2019 Energy Aggregation Program to the residents. After the presentation the meeting was opened up to the public for comment.

Tom Jefferson, 18 Knoll Circle – Mr. Jefferson opted to join Clear View energy after the previous energy aggregation program ended, and he wanted to know how can he enroll with Constellation. Mr. Chilton stated that he can go the toll free number and supply his 20-digit customer number and will be enrolled in the program.

Patricia Overum – Mrs. Overum had some billing issues with Tri-Eagle, but would like to be rerolled in this program. She mistakenly mailed out the opt out card, but she will call to be enrolled. She asked how JCP&L buys their energy.

Mr. Fusaro stated that Tri-Eagle did not do well with budget billing and this will not be repeated with Constellation.

Mr. Chilton explained how JCP&L buys energy.

Julia Welsh 1041 B Canterbury Dr. – Mrs. Welsh inquired if JCP&L have any power plants which produce power. She also stated that her bill and some of her neighbors’ electric bills doubled.

Mr. Fusaro commented that there is a different rate during the summer, and the rate increases a lot after the first 600 kwatt/hr.
